

Team Exercise – Person Centered Planning

Scenario One:

Mr. Jones enjoys coming to the friendship center during the day for activities on Wednesdays and Fridays. She has been consistently attending every week for three years and is healthy and alert. One day she arrives to the center and you notice her gait has become unsteady and she requests assistance with the bathroom. What do you do?

Scenario Two:

Mrs. Green is caring for her 85 year old father. He lives alone and needs help with most of his daily living needs. Mrs. Green works full time and has no other family or friends to help her father. Her father does not want to leave his home and Mrs. Green wants to honor that request. How do you assist her and her father?

Scenario Three:

Scenario Four:

Mrs. George's daughter June contacts you reporting that her mother, who is 90 years old and lives alone, has a man in her life who appears to be taking advantage of Mrs. George financially. How do you assist in this matter?
